Robert Oates expressed his concern on the restrictions with regards to being 75 feet from the shoreline, hours of operation, sailboats within the 75 feet restrictions, 10 MPH speed limit within the 75 feet.

Indian Lake Marina questioned the reasoning behind 50 HP limit on rental boats provided by the Marina as it will cost the Marina significant money to replace the engines on the current rental fleet.

John Emerick questioned the reason for the provision on tying up on weekends between eleven o'clock and dusk.
