The Meeting was called to order at 6:03 P.M. by Lynn Shimer, Council President.

ORDER OF BUSINESS

1. John Oliver Zoning Hearing Board Appeal Update – Attorney Rullo reported that he did forward a copy of the Commonwealth Courts Ruling to all Council Members for their review. On May 23, 2016, the Court affirmed Judge Klementik’s decision relative to the reversal of the decision of the Zoning Hearing Board in regard to the outdoor furnace. However, the Court did reverse Judge Klementik’s decision in regard to the out building.

Council requested that Attorney Rullo contact Mr. Oliver and advise him that Council was still interested in reaching a compromise to this matter.

2. LCT Energy Settlement Proposal - Hanson made a motion to authorize Attorney Rullo to proceed with the settlement proposal with LCT Energy and to authorize the officers of the Borough to execute the proposed settlement. Hollern seconded the motion. All ayes, motion carried.

3. Craig Aber, Drip Irrigation Sewer System – Hanson stated that the manufacturer of the drip irrigation system will not allow anyone other than a trained representative inside the box. St. Clair Construction was okay with backing away from inspecting this type of system. So in light of these facts, Council instructed Hanson to execute the agreement with Mr. Aber.

4. Old Business – None.

5. New Business – Morgese made a motion to authorize the Borough Manager to release the one hundred (100) non-powered licenses that were authorized to be released after the July 4<sup>th</sup> weekend now and to issue an additional fifty (50) after the July 4<sup>th</sup> weekend. Marhefka made a motion to table this issue. There was no second to table. Hanson seconded Morgese’s motion. 5 ayes and 1 naye. Motion carried.

With no further business to discuss, Hollern moved and Morgese seconded to adjourn the meeting at 7:42 P.M. All ayes, motion carried.
