ORDINANCE NO. 119

AN ORDINANCE OF INDIAN LAKE BOROUGH, SOMERSET COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA AUTHORIZING THE BOROUGH TO JOIN WITH OTHER LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNITS AS A MEMBER OF THE PENNSYLVANIA INTERGOVERNMENTAL RISK MANAGMENT ASSOCIATION; AND TO, ENTER INTO AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL CONTRACT ESTABLISHING A LOCAL GOVERNMENT RISK POOL FOR JOINT OR COOPERATIVE ACTION BY MEMBERS, ACCORDING TO THEIR RESPECTIVE FINANCIAL AND ADMINISTRATIVE RESOURCES, FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING RISK MANAGEMENT SERVICES AND RISK SHARING FACILITIES TO THE MEMBERS AND THEIR EMPLOYEES AND TO DEFEND AND PROTECT THE MEMBERS OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT RISK POOL AGAINST LIABILITY IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE INTERGOVERNMENTAL CONTRACT.

WHEREAS, the Pennsylvania Intergovernmental Risk Management Association (the "Association") was established by the authority contained in the Pennsylvania Intergovernmental Cooperation Act, 52 Pa. C.S.A. § 2301 et seq.; and

WHEREAS, the Act provides that any intergovernmental cooperation agreement shall be deemed in force as to each municipality which is a party thereto when the agreement has been adopted by ordinances of all of the cooperating municipalities which are parties thereto;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the authority of the Borough Council of Indian Lake Borough of Somerset County, Pennsylvania, and it is HEREBY ENACTED and ORDAINED by authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1: Indian Lake Borough shall become a member of the Pennsylvania
Intergovernmental Risk Management Association in accordance with the provisions of
the Pennsylvania Intergovernmental Cooperation Act and shall execute the
Intergovernmental Contract prepared for that purpose, which is incorporated herein by
reference, and a copy of same shall be filed with the minutes of the meeting at which this
Ordinance is adopted.

SECTION 2: The President of the Indian Lake Borough Council and the Borough Secretary are authorized to execute the Intergovernmental Contract referred to above for the purposes contained therein, as well as any amendments or modifications thereto which may be required from time to time.

SECTION 3: The Pennsylvania Intergovernmental Risk Management Association is hereby designated as the official custodian of the funds of Indian Lake Borough which are deposited with the Association for the purposes set forth in the Intergovernmental Contract.

SECTION 4: As required by the Intergovernmental Cooperation Act, the Borough's membership in the Association shall be upon the following terms and conditions:

- (a) The conditions of the Agreement, as set forth in the Intergovernmental Contract referred to in Section 1, which are incorporated herein by reference;
- (b) Indian Lake Borough's participation in the Association shall be terminable at any time by Ordinance;
- (c) The purposes and objectives of the Agreement, including the powers and scope of authority delegated in the Agreement, are as set forth in the Intergovernmental Contract referred to in Section 1, and the same are incorporated herein by reference;
- (d) The Borough's participation in the Agreement shall be financed through the contributions by the Borough to the Association, according to its "Basis Rate" as that term is defined in the Intergovernmental Contract.
- (e) The Association shall be managed by a Board of Commissioners or Executive Committee as set forth in the By-laws of the Association, a copy of which shall be filed with the minutes of the meeting at which this Ordinance is adopted;

(f) All property of the Association, whether real or personal, shall be acquired, managed and disposed of by the Association in accordance with the terms of the Intergovernmental Contract;

(g) The Association shall have the power to enter into contracts for policies of group insurance and employee benefits, including Social Security, for the Borough's employees and officers as provided by law.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall become effective upon enactment, as provided by law.
