AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE DISCHARGE OF ANY GUN OR ANY FIRE ARM AND PROHIBITING THE HUNTING OF ANY GAME WHETHER OR NOT IN HUNTING SEASON WITHIN THE BOROUGH OF INDIAN LAKE AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION FOR THE BOROUGH OF INDIAN LAKE, SOMERSET COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

The Borough of Indian Lake hereby ordains as follows:

SECTION 1: No person shall, except in necessary and lawful defense of person or property, fire or discharge any gun or other fire arm within the Borough of Indian Lake except in the area of the Indian Lake shooting range. All hunting, whether for small or large game, is prohibited at any time within the limits of the Borough of Indian Lake.

SECTION 2: Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof before the Mayor or any Justice of the Peace of the Borough, be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than Three Hundred and 00/100 (\$300.00) Dollars and costs of prosecution and in default of payment of such fine and costs to imprisonment of not more than (30) days.

Any Ordinance or part of an Ordinance conflicting with the provisions of this Ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed.

ORDAINED AND ENACTED into law this 19th day of May, 1967.
