## ORDINANCE NO. 73

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 59, 67, 68 AND 71 OF THE BOROUGH OF INDIAN LAKE, SOMERSET COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, REGULATING THE USE AND ENJOYMENT FOR RECREATIONAL AND OTHER PURPOSES OF INDIAN LAKE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Indian Lake, Somerset County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained by the authority of the same as follows:

Article I: Ordinance No. 59, Article II, <u>Rules For</u> Operation Of Boats: Section 202, <u>Operating Boats</u>, Subsection h, which provides:

"All boats must carry an approved type of life preserver for each occupant. All water skiers must wear an approved life preserver."

is hereby amended to read:

"All boats must carry an approved type of life preserver for each occupant and all boats 16 feet long or greater shall also carry at least one approved throwable life-saving device, along with the other required preservers. Further, all motorized watercraft shall carry an approved, portable, nontoxic discharge fire extinguisher. Finally, all water skiers must wear an approved life preserver." Article II: Ordinance No. 59, Article II, <u>Rules For</u> Operation Of Boats: Section 202, <u>Operating Boats</u>: Subsection g which provides as follows:

"Boats pulling water skiers shall have at least one other occupant besides the operator who shall act as an observer of the skier. Tow ropes will not exceed eighty (80) feet in length and will not be left trailing in the water when not being used."

is hereby amended to read:

"Section g. Boats pulling water skiers shall have at least one other occupant besides the operator, who shall act as an observer of the skier and be capable of providing assistance to the skier. Tow ropes will not exceed eighty (80) feet in length, except for the special event of Barefoot Water Skiing during which times the tow rope shall not exceed one hundred (100) feet in length, and will not be left trailing in the water when not being used."

Article III: Ordinance No. 59, Article II, Rules For Operation Of Boats as amended by Ordinance No. 67 and No. 11, Section 202, Operating Boats, Subsection k which provides:

"Beginning January 1, 1987, no sail boats, jet skis, wet bikes, and wind surfers shall be operated on

the waters of Indian Lake on Saturdays, Sundays and holidays between the hours of 12 p.m. and 5 p.m." is hereby repealed.

<u>Article IV</u>: Ordinance No. 59, Article I, <u>Licensing And</u> <u>Regulation And Boating In General</u>, as amended by Ordinance No. 61, Section 102, <u>Boat Licenses</u>, Subsection K, which provides:

"The boat license must be displayed at all times on the left (port) side of the vessel adjacent to the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania boat permit." is hereby amended to read:

The boat license must be displayed at all times on the left (port) side of the boat licensed, immediately adjacent to and following the valid, current Pennsylvania state boating license. If said license is not so displayed, the operator of said craft shall be informed that he or she may purchase another Indian Lake boat sticker for a reasonable fee, which must be properly affixed to the craft within seventy-two (72) hours of said notice."

All other Ordinances or parts of Ordinances Article V: inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
