

Resolution #1989-2

RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF INDIAN LAKE

WHEREAS, the Legislature of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania has by Act No. 156 of 1988 enacted Legislation allowing certain small games of chance to be conducted by certain Non-Profit Associations, and the licensing thereof; and,

WHEREAS, said Act provides that in any municipality an election may be held on the date of the primary election immediately preceding any municipal election to determine the desire of the electors with respect to the issuance of small games of chance licenses within the limits of such municipality; and,

WHEREAS, said Act further provides that the governing body of such municipality may, by Resolution, request the County Board of Elections to place such question on the ballot; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the Borough of Indian Lake, and it is hereby resolved by the authority of the same as follows:

Section I: That the Borough of Indian Lake requests the Somerset County Board of Elections place on the ballot for the Borough of Indian Lake at the next primary election before a municipal election, which said election is to be held on May 16, 1989, a referendum on the question of granting licenses for said games of chance in the Borough of Indian Lake. That said question be presented as follows:

"Do You Favor the Issuance of Licenses to Conduct Small Games of Chance in the Borough of Indian Lake."

Section II: That the aforesaid election proceedings shall be in the manner and subject to the provisions of the Pennsylvania Election Code.
