RESOLUTION FOR THE HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF INDIAN LAKE BOROUGH, SOMERSET COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

WHEREAS, the Borough of Indian Lake, Somerset County, is vulnerable to natural hazards like flooding, wind and weather hazards, and human-caused hazards that can result in property loss, loss of life, economic hardship and threats to public heath and safety,

WHEREAS, a Somerset County Hazard Vulnerability Assessment and Mitigation Plan has been developed by Somerset County Hazard Mitigation Planning Committee and the people of the County,

WHEREAS, the Somerset County Hazard Vulnerability Assessment and Mitigation Plan recommends mitigation activities that will reduce losses to life and property affected by the natural hazards that face Indian Lake Borough, and

WHEREAS, a series of public meetings were held to develop and review the plan,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Indian Lake that:

- The Somerset County Hazard Vulnerability Assessment and Mitigation Plan is hereby adopted as an official plan of the Borough of Indian Lake.
- By September 30th each year, the Somerset County Hazard Mitigation Planning Committee shall prepare an annual evaluation report to the Borough Council of the Borough of Indian Lake.
- The respective Borough officials and agencies identified in the strategy of the Plan are hereby directed to implement the recommended activities assigned to them. They will consult semi-annually with the Somerset County Hazard Mitigation Planning Committee on the progress of their activities.
