Once a wake boat sped past us on the lake, created such a wake passing us, our pontoon nose dived and took on water. There were 10 people on our boat. We all screamed it was quite scary. Luckily our boat righted itself, but from that point on I refused to go out on the lake if it's crowded or if there are a lot of wake board boats.

We try to ski early in the morning and tube when the water has more disturbance. Paddleboarding is nearly impossible as soon as wake boats are out. Canoeing also becomes difficult. There are times when we feel unsafe boating, at the point on the marina side near entrance to narrows, when multiple wake boats are lined up.

DINER, THEN BACK OUT FOR SKI OR SURF DEPENDING ON THE DAY.

When boat waves become excessive to reduce pleasure on the water to having to consistently maneuver to keep from taking waves over the bow.

Rarely do we avoid going out in the boat for these reasons. However common sense guides us to tow tubes, skis and wake boarders during non peak times for the enjoyment of calm waters.
