However, increased enforcement of existing laws and some time restrictions seem reasonable. Stop selling condos.

I question if Indian Lake is wide enough for wake boats.

I do support restricted hours for wake surfing. not early which destroys water for slalom, not late, when people enjoy cruising with or without booze. I like education and the current approach of trying to be good neighbors.

Pledge from all boat pilots not just owners- owners provide a list of pilots with an annual application and they must sign pledge with guidelines.

Flat front shore walls have increased significantly over the years, these send lake energy directly back into the lake. These should be enhanced with riprap or rocks to dissipate energy.

In many studies it is recommended to maintain 500 feet from the shore or an obstruction when wake surfing to be equal to a sport boat at 100 feet off-shore.

Changing certain boating requirements such as boat weight, hp, wake enhancement capabilities would provide better management of Indian Lake licenses as well as

enforcements. If measures to control the lake are continued as is, Indian Lake shall continue to play catch up to technology and innovation. IL is not big enough to support the pontoon boats with 400 HP motors r advanced wake technologies and specialty power boats and speed capabilities of new jet ski machines.
